<b>December 5 - February 3</b>	Complete Winter Universal Reading Screener	
<b>February 1</b>	All districts/schools must provide parent notification for any student who is at-risk for retention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These notifications should be attached to the Home Literacy Report required for students with a significant reading deficiency</li> <li>• Recommended attachment: Summer Programming Application (for pre-planning in staffing and budget and prioritizing conversations with families)</li> </ul>	Launch of District Summer Programming Prioritized Registration  Recommend Additional Literacy Acceleration for At-Risk Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• High-dosage, low-ratio tutoring</li> <li>• Literacy grants to families for after-school tutoring</li> <li>• Partnerships with after-school providers to support literacy</li> <li>• RTI<sup>2</sup> programming adjustments</li> </ul>

<b>May 19</b>	3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade ELA TCAP Raw Data Due to Districts	Information may not be used in place of scale scores but can reasonably be used to identify those students likely to be at "Below" or in the bottom half of "Approaching." Some parent notifications can begin
<b>May 26</b>	<b>Raw Score to Scale Score Tables Released to Districts</b> Districts can determine student proficiency

<b>June 7</b>	<b>All</b> 3 <sup>rd</sup> Grade ELA TCAP Retake Scores reported	
<b>June 24</b>	Final Retention notification for families (who did not participate in intervention options)	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 30 days before the first day of school
<b>June 26</b>	Launch of Post Test for Summer Programming and window for the retest	
<b>June 30</b>	Parent Appeal Portal Closes	
<b>July 14</b>	Final Retention notification for families (who participated in summer programming)	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 10 days before the first day of school



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
